



Thanks Badge I

Requires a nomination letter and two endorsement letters.

The Thanks Badge honors an individual whose ongoing commitment, leadership, and service has had an exceptional, measurable impact on meeting the mission-delivery goals and priorities of the entire council or the entire Girl Scout Movement. This award is presented annually.

Criteria

- The nominee is an active, registered adult Girl Scout in good standing.
- The outstanding service performed by the nominee resulted in outcomes that benefited the total council or the entire Girl Scout Movement and is so significantly above and beyond the call of duty that no other award would be appropriate.

Possible candidates may include: Any registered volunteer that supports the entire council or the Girl Scout Movement such as Council Trainers, Council Committee Members, Council Delegates, etc.

Examples may include, but not limited to: Canoe certified volunteer who provides support at all council events that offer canoeing; a volunteer who is involved with fund development for our council; a Council Trainer who offers training throughout the council; a Delegate who represents the council at the GS National Convention; a volunteer who has served on the Gold Award committee for many years, etc.
