

# Cookie Wheelbarrow

## Supplies:

1. Empty cookie case
  2. Two or Three empty cookie packages
  3. Two large (5 gallon) paint sticks (handles)
  4. One regular paint stick (sign holder)
  5. Two old CDs or (round pieces of cardboard)
  6. One wooden dowel
  7. Electrical Tape
  8. Packing tape or Duct tape
  9. Hot glue or strong adhesive (adult use only)
  10. Sign materials (Markers, colored cardstock, white paper, foam shapes, glue, tape)
  11. Paint or markers (for handles) (Optional)
- \*Be sure to paint the handles (5 gallon paint sticks in advance of the event so that they will be dry and ready to handle. Spray paint works well for this.
12. Ribbon for decoration (Optional)



## Instructions:

1. Pre-paint the handles to match the cookie case, or provide markers for girls to use for coloring and decorating the two handles (5 gallon paint sticks).
2. Fold the top flaps of the case inwards.
3. Insert the handles into the handle holes in the two long flaps, and secure the flaps down with strong tape or hot glue (hot glue should be applied by an adult).
4. Glue a cookie carton to the bottom of the case.
5. Cut out the cookie from the back of the cookie package, as a 3 1/4" to 3 1/2" diameter circle. Cut a hole in the center to match the hole in the CD and secure the cookie picture to the CD.
5. Tape the wooden dowel to the bottom and place a CD on either end for wheels. Use electrical tape on the tips of the wooden dowel to secure.
6. Create a sign, attach to a paint stick and secure to cookie case.
7. Decorate with a ribbon & have fun!
