

Girls Guiding Girls to Girl Scouts: 100th Anniversary Girl Recruitment Program

Program Synopsis

Have you ever wanted to share the love of Girl Scouts? Starting in January, Girl Scouts can do just that, in the Girls Guiding Girls to Girl Scouts (GGGS) program. Girl Scouts of every age level are encouraged to ask one or more girls to join Girl Scouts. Both girls will fill out their portion of the GGGS registration form to qualify and the recruited girl will need to attend a **minimum of three** Girl Scout activities. These activities can be fulfilled through a Troop experience, Service Unit Event or Council sponsored program, series or Day/Resident Camp. Girls can mix and match or take part in more than three activities. After completing the activities, the girl and her Girl Scout Recruiter will be invited to a special **FREE** event in August to celebrate.

Let's see how fast we can add 100 girls to Girl Scouts during our 100th Anniversary!

Requirements

- Registered Girl Scouts (all age levels) in the GGGS program will need to recruit (at the minimum) one girl that is not currently registered as a Girl Scout for the 2011-2012 membership year to join Girl Scouts. Girls do not have to recruit girls at their age level.
- Both girls will fill out their portions of the GGGS registration form on the back of this page. The recruited girl must register using the GGGS registration form and return it between **January 12, 2012-March 12, 2012**. **All registration forms must be postmarked on or before March 12, 2012 to qualify for the benefits listed below.**
- After the GGGS registration form is submitted with the recruited girl's \$12 Girl Scout registration fee (mail to **GSSI -Attention: Chelsey Banaskavich #4 Ginger Creek Parkway Glen Carbon, IL 62034**), the girls can start attending Girl Scout activities. Financial Assistance is available for those who qualify. A completed Opportunity Fund (financial assistance) application (available on our website at www.gsofsi.org or upon request) must be sent with the GGGS registration form to waive the \$12 Girl Scout registration fee.
- Recruited girls will be required to attend **three activities** (including, but not limited to: Troop meetings/outings, Service Unit or local Girl Scout events, Council events publicized in the Program Book or Links to Leaders, Day Camp and/or Resident Camp). The recruited girl will be able to mix and match any three (or more) Girl Scout activities to complete the Girls Guiding Girls to Girl Scouts program. The recruited girls do not have to attend events with their Girl Scout Recruiter. **Please note:** the recruited girl will need to remove the wallet card attached to this page and record the Girl Scout activities she attends during **January 12, 2012-August 2012** (the GGGS celebration event **does not** qualify as one of the three activities). The completed wallet card will be the admission into the August GGGS celebration event and will be collected at that time.
- When the registration is received at the Girl Scouts of Southern Illinois (GSSI) office, a confirmation welcome letter or e-mail (if e-mail address is provided) will be sent to the Girl Scout recruiter/parents and the recruited girl/parents within 3 weeks of receipt. The letter will be accompanied by a Program Book for the recruited girl.
