

# Home Study Courses

Do impossible schedules make it difficult to attend required adult education training? If so, you'll want to check-out the home studies available for download. (They are also available through your Service Unit Training Coordinator or Director.)

Home Study Courses are an alternative way to fulfill your training requirements. The content of the home-study courses and classroom courses is nearly identical. However, home study courses do not have group activities or provisions for sharing with other volunteers. They are designed for individuals to proceed at their own pace and require extensive reading. You will need the required books and resources as outlined in each home study course. Once the answer booklet is reviewed for accuracy, you will receive notification to indicate a successful completion of the course.
