Changes in GS Bronze, GS Silver, & GS Gold Awards

GSUSA has changed the requirements for the GS Bronze, GS Silver, and GS Gold Awards. These changes will take effect September 2009.

FORMER GIRL SCOUTS OF RIVER BLUFFS: Any girl who received the GS Silver Award and GS Gold Award trainings prior to September 2009 will complete the award under the **OLD** requirements (the requirements shared in their training). Anyone taking training September 2009 and after will complete the award under the **NEW** requirements. Any girl that is pursuing the GS Bronze Award after Oct. 1, 2009 will complete the award under the NEW requirements. If a girl or troop is in the midst of working on their GS Bronze Award, they **MUST** notify Carolyn Miener **BEFORE OCT 1, 2009** to let her know that they are working on their GS Bronze Award using the OLD requirements. GS Junior leaders can email their list of girls by using the email address below. Be sure and include your troop number along with the girl/s name. If they do not notify her by Oct 1, 2009, then they will be required to complete the award under the NEW requirements. You can contact Carolyn at (618) 692-0692 x113 or at cmiener@riverbluffs.org.

FORMER GIRL SCOUTS OF SHAGBARK: Girls that are in the process of working on the GS Bronze, GS Silver, and the GS Gold Awards under the **OLD** requirements, **MUST** notify Jackie Gomez no later than **OCT 1, 2009** to let her know that you are working on the awards. If you have not notified Jackie by OCT 1, 2009, for the GS Silver and the GS Gold Awards, you will be required to take the GS Silver Award and/or GS Gold Award training and complete the awards under the NEW requirements. For the GS Bronze Award, you will be required to complete it under the NEW requirements.
