Location: 15230 N. Blue Point Trail, Effingham, IL 62401

Directions: From I-70, take exit 160 and turn LEFT onto IL-Rt. 32N/IL-Rt. 33W and continue to Lake Sara Rd. Turn LEFT onto Lake Sara Rd. and continue to Moccasin Rd. Turn RIGHT onto Moccasin Rd and continue to N. Blue Point Trail. Turn left onto N. Blue Point Trail. Continue on this road as it winds its way to dead end at the camp gate.

Fines and damages: Troops/Service Units will be assessed fines if camp property and/or equipment is damaged during their stay. Fines will be based upon labor and parts required to repair or to replace the damaged equipment or unit. Fines may also be assessed if the camp facilities are not left in the same condition they were in upon arrival. In other words, leave the camp in the same or better condition than you found it. - ✓ **Archery:** Any archery activity must have prior approval and proper certification. Please contact Customer Care for more information.
- ✓ **Equipment:** When making plans for camp, please submit an Equipment Requisition form two weeks prior to your reservation and email the form to Customer Care at customecare@gsofsi.org.
- ✓ **Fishing:** Any one 16 years and older must have a fishing license and follow the Illinois Department of Conservation rules and regulations. Fishing may only be done from the bank of the lake.
- ✓ **Hiking:** Trails are marked on the map below and at camp.
- ✓ **Trash:** All trash must be bagged and disposed of as directed by the Camp Ranger.
- ✓ **Unit Information:** All cabins sleep 4 people unless otherwise noted above. Cabins have electricity but no heat/a/c. Bunkbeds, cots, and mattresses are not to be moved or removed from cabins or lodges.
