

VOLUNTEER RESOURCES

CPR/AED/First Aid Training Clarification:

A "First-Aider" is a registered adult volunteer who has taken Girl Scout approved First-aid and CPR training that includes specific instructions for **child** CPR, as well as AED (Automated External Defibrillator) training. It is recommended that each troop have at least one adult volunteer serve as the "First-Aider" for the troop. Girl Scouts of Southern Illinois highly recommends a troop have more than one person trained.

Courses that are fully online are not accepted. Course certifications need to be earn through in-person training or blended learning (online & in-person) programs.
