How can we participate?

We challenge each Service Unit to sell 18% more than they did in the traditional program. This new goal amount can be found in eBudde on the Service Unit dashboard.

GSofSI is going to offer No Risk Cookie Pickups!

- There will be 10 different locations from which troops can pick up cookies.
- Troops will place their order into eBudde just like they would for a regular cupboard order.
- If troops have any unsold cookies that were picked up during this new period, they must return them by the last day the cookie cupboard location is open.
- Digital Cookie will be open for this Take 2 season.
- If a troop would like to participate in Take 2 Season, we will allow them to do a One-Time Cookie Exchange. Troops must be ordering more cookies than what they want to exchange. The link can be found on the website. <u>Take 2 Cookie Program</u>



INCENTIVES

- Service Units:
 - Service Units will earn \$0.05 for each additional package sold after April 1st.
 - Once the Service Unit reaches its new goal, it will earn \$0.10 per package.
 - The Service Unit that sells the highest percentage during this time will earn a SU campout at Camp Torqua!
- Troops:
 - Troops will earn \$1.20 per package
- Girl Scouts:
 - Each girl who sells 50 packages during this time period will earn a coupon for \$10 off a Special Retail Item that will be announced at the end of April.
 - The top five (5) sellers during this Take 2 time frame who sell a minimum of 200 boxes will earn an all-expense-paid trip to the 2026 Girl Scouts National Convention in Washington, D.C. for themselves and one caregiver.

Cookie Crumble Information

- eBudde will look just the same. All the data from the regular season is still in the system.
- To give credit to girls for the sales during this period, you will need to keep track outside of eBudde.
- When a troop is ready to return or finalize their sales, a form will be available for them to fill out, reporting the number of girls who participated and the total amount sold. This same form will be used to report the unsold cookies that they will be returning.
- We will process an ACH on June 4th for all troops that participated.
- If a troop wants to exchange cookies, the cookies must be in full case amounts and be damage-free.
