Some Space Camp FAQs:

Where will I stay?

Campers will stay on-site at the Habitat Space Camp facilities. Campers will be placed in bunk rooms and are separated by gender. 24 hour security is provided. Lockers are provided for campers to store belongings, but must supply their own locks. Campers should pack bed linens or a sleeping bag and pillow.

What will I eat during camp?

All meals during space camp are on-site. Campers will be offered a hot meal consisting of protein, starch, vegetables as well as an option for an alternative item. Salads, fruit cups and ice cream will be available for all lunch and dinner meals.

What do I leave at home?

NO outside food or beverages. All snacks will be discarded upon arrival. Snacks containing nuts/peanuts, may contain nuts, or processed in a facility with nuts are not allowed and will be immediately discarded without reimbursement.

What do I bring?

Please see sample packing list items below

- Face Masks
- Hand sanitizer
- Closed-toed shoes
- Water bottle
- Backpack or day pack
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Cameras and video cameras are encouraged
- Change or \$1 bills for vending machines
- Money for gift shop
- Bed linens (twin sheets, pillowcase, blanket and/or sleeping bag)
- Pillow
- Towels and washcloths
- Padlock for your locker (make sure campers know how to use the lock)
- Toiletries: soap, deodorant, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.
- Appropriate clothing for changing weather conditions
- Cell phone (Cell phone usage by trainees is not permitted during the program activities.)
- Portable charger and/or charger plugs and cords for mobile devices
- Shower shoes
